

Information booths 2026: Conditions for participation

1. Basics

Munich Pride provides non-profit associations, groups and initiatives of the LGBTIQ* communities with free information booth space during the street festival in the Ludwigstreet (PrideMile) from June 26 to 28, 2026. For public institutions, larger organizations and companies there is a graduated cost sharing, please ask when registering. The positions for the information booths will be assigned by Munich Pride. Registration is subject to approval of PrideMile by the authorities.

2. Registration & deadline

Registration must be done online at www.csdmuenchen.de and confirmed by Munich Pride. Registration deadline is Friday, May 22, 2026.

3. Booth size

The standard size of an information stand is 3 x 3 meters.

4. Conditions of use

The information stands provided free of charge may only be used to provide information about the idealistic concerns of the participants. The integration of sponsors is not permitted. Active distribution of information material or collecting donations is only possible directly at the stand. No food may be distributed, with the exception of hygienically individually packaged, small giveaway items such as jelly bear bags. No music may be played.

5. Operating days & positions

Information stands can be operated for one day (Saturday, June 27 only), two days (Friday, June 26 & Saturday, June 27), or three days (Friday, June 26 to Sunday, June 28). One- and two-day information stands are located in the northern area between Oskar-von-Miller-Ring and Siegestor, while three-day information stands are located in the southern area between Odeonsplatz and Oskar-von-Miller-Ring.

6. Street festival operating hours & core hours for information stands

The operating hours of the PrideMile are planned as follows, subject to official approval (core hours for the operation of the information stands are in parentheses):

Friday, June 26, 4 pm to 1 am (core hours for information stands 4 pm to 9 pm)

Saturday, June 27, 2 pm to 1 am (core hours for information stands 2 pm to 9 pm)

Sunday, June 28, 4 pm to 11 pm (core hours for information stands 4 pm to 9 pm).

Operating hours may be reduced in critical weather conditions and in cases of force majeure.

Please note: Making our diverse LGBTIQ* community visible is a central concern of Munich Pride and should also be reflected in the information stands integrated into the PrideMile. In addition, a seamless information stand area contributes significantly to the positive overall impression of the PrideMile. It is therefore important that all information stands are actually operated on all registered days and during the entire core hours. If this is not possible, please inform Munich Pride. If this important rule is not complied with without good reason, we reserve the right to block participation in subsequent years.

7. Setup/teardown times & transport trips

Setting up one-day information stands: Saturday betw. 8 am and 12 pm. Between 12 noon and 2 pm, the street festival grounds will be inspected by the auth., so a representative of the participant must be present at the stand.

Setting up two-/three-day information stands: Friday between 10 am and 2 pm. Between 2 pm and 4 pm, the street festival grounds will be inspected by the auth., so a representative of the participant must be present at the stand.

Dismantling: Possible on all days at the earliest after the end of core hours.

Transportation trips with vehicles: For security reasons, transport is only possible before the start and after the end of the PrideMile's operating hours. During operating hours, the PrideMile is completely secured with anti-terrorism barriers. The time slots for transport trips are:

Friday from 10 am to 2 pm / from 2 am.

Saturday from 8 am to 12 noon / from 2 am

and Sunday from 10 am to 2 pm / from midnight

A one-way system is in place on the site; access is only possible via Oskar-von-Miller-Ring or Von-der-Tann-Straße. All participants will receive an access permit from Munich Pride in advance, which must be displayed visibly in the vehicle's windshield.

8. Special regulations for information stands lasting several days

All information stands that are open for several days must be secured for the night at the end of each operating day, depending on the weather conditions, or dismantled if necessary. Munich Pride commissions a security company to provide night security for the street festival. However, Munich Pride expressly accepts no liability for any theft, vandalism, or weather damage.

9. Fire safety regulations for information stands

9.1. All pavilions used must comply with fire protection class B1 (flame retardant). This can be proven in two ways during the official inspection: by means of a test certificate from the manufacturer, printed out or stored digitally on a cell phone, or by means of a test label sewn into the tent by the manufacturer.

9.2. Each participant must have a functional small fire extinguisher with at least 2 kg of extinguishing agent (fire class A/B).

9.3. Pavilions must be secured against wind; for this purpose, at least 15 kg of suitable weights must be attached to each support leg.

10. Rental pavilions

If there is sufficient interest, Munich Pride can provide rental pavilions through a service provider. These rental pavilions comply with the fire safety regulations specified in point 9 (including fire extinguishers and weights) and are assembled/disassembled by the service provider. The cost contribution is expected to be in the low three-digit range and will be invoiced by Munich Pride. Participants can indicate their non-binding interest in a rental pavilion when registering online.

11. Loss of eligibility

The participants commit themselves to follow the instructions of the staff of Munich Pride, the contracted security company and municipal authorities as well as the police. Whoever violates these conditions of participation loses his right to participate and can be expelled from the street festival area. In severe cases, a ban for coming years is also possible.

12. Other

Should there be any changes by the authorities to the conditions after registration, Munich Pride will inform the participants. These changes will automatically become part of the conditions of participation.
